

Hong Kong Nuclear Society (HKNS) Inaugural Symposium

Fukushima: One Year After – Way Forward on Safety & Risk

The newly formed HKNS, together with the City University of Hong Kong's Department of Mechanical and Biomedical Engineering have invited experts from Japan, Mainland China, Taiwan, France and the US to reflect on the Fukushima accident. Civic Exchange is supporting the captioned event.

Governments around the world have taken different decisions: having conducted safety reviews and articulated steps to decrease risks, the majority has pledged continuing support for nuclear energy, while Germany, Switzerland and Italy are withdrawing from nuclear energy. Japan is considering its way forward. Mainland China concluded its safety review of all its nuclear plants in October 2011, and will soon release reports relating to nuclear safety and the further expansion of nuclear energy. Experts from Japan, China, Taiwan, France and the US will share their knowledge and experience on the decisions their countries made post-Fukushima.
